All scholarships are awarded based on a point system, developed and/or specified by, the sponsors of the scholarships. All scholarships (EXCEPT for the Montana Bowling Proprietors) will be available to the selected individuals for a period of three (3) years after they graduate from high school. The Montana Bowling Proprietors Scholarship will be available for a period of 1 year. In the event of a tie, the applicants will be asked to write a 150-word essay about their specific college and future plans. Judging will be based on inclusion of specific goals, clarity, organization, logic and neatness.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered, all candidates MUST:

1. Be a graduating senior.
2. Be a current member of a sanctioned USBC league in Montana and be in good standing for the current season.
3. Have unimpaired amateur standing in all athletic participation.
4. Have bowled at least four (4) years, (3 years for girls) in a sanctioned USBC league in Montana.
5. NOT bowled or participated in MUSBC Adult leagues or tournaments, jackpots, Monte Carlo's, etc.
(EXCEPTION—it is acceptable to bowl in an adult singles league as long as any prize money is sent to SMART.)
6. Have bowled in a MBPA member house to be eligible for the Montana Bowling Proprietor Memorial Scholarships.
7. Include SAT/ACT test results if available in Part III of the application.
8. Send **two (2)** sets of the completed application and requested attachments only to the Scholarship Committee Chair NO LATER THAN MARCH 1. **Note: Applications postmarked after March 1 will not be accepted!!!**
9. Attend a college, university, vocational-technical school or other accredited school of higher learning.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Each Candidate will:

1. Give Part II to their Coach and ask that he/she complete the form and return it to them.
2. Give Part III to a school Teacher or Counselor and request that they complete the form and return it.
3. Complete Part I, page 1 and 2, and have your Coach sign the completed form.
4. Obtain the completed forms from their Coach and Teacher/Counselor early enough to allow time to mail the application.
5. Make **two (2)** copies of each page of the completed scholarship application (Part 1, page 1 & 2, Part II, and Part III) and any additional information provided by their coach and/or teacher.
6. Submit the original and **one (1)** copy of the completed application to the Scholarship Committee Chair listed below, making sure your applications are postmarked no later than March 1. Keep one (1) copy yourself.
