***New Points System – Each athlete will earn 5 pts for each stop they compete at, 1 pt. for high game each game, 1 pt. for high series, 3 pts for #1 qualifying seed, 2pts for #2 qualifying seed, 1 pt. for #3 qualifying seed, and 3 pts to champion. Prizes (TBD) for athletes with the most points.

Format: This is a certified Adult/Youth scratchleagu1st stop will start with a quick league meeting to introduce the officers of the league and recap the rules. The first seven stops will consist of 6 games broken down into 3 sets of 2, head-to-head, scratch matches (30 pins bonus to the winner of each game). Bowlers will be paired off by average for the first match and then by total pins with bonus pins for the remaining matches. The final stop will consist of 4 sets. There are two age divisions. Bowlers born between 8/1/01 and 7/31/06 will be placed in the Major Division. Bowlers born on 8/1/06 or later will be placed in the Junior Division. Rotation of different stepladder types. Final Stop will most likely be a **JR GOLD Qualifier**. Call or email Terri Johnson if you have any questions.

Dress Code – Goal of this dress code is to prepare bowlers for tournament competition in which a professional athletic dress is standard. Appropriate bowling competition attire must be worn (knee length cargo or walking shorts are allowed but no basketball shorts or yoga pants and skirts must be longer than fingertip length), no hats. Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.

18-Year-Old and older Athletes – Must complete the free U.S. Center for SafeSport online education program in to compete with participants under the age of 18. Bowlers who turn 18 during this league season will have to complete the training before the next Big Sky Tour Event upon turning 18. Minor athletes are also able to take SafeSport but not required.
